

Grammar point: 文法

- These photos are the best ones Cooper took in the photo contest because you're great at expressing feelings with your eyes.

解析：“because you're great at expressing feelings with your eyes” is a dependent clause. A dependent clause has a subject and a verb, but it does not include a complete thought. In this case, it cannot stand alone as a complete sentence. It is marked by a dependent marker. In this example, “because” is a dependent marker and the part introduced by it is thus called a dependent clause.

例句：I like this film because it is very educational.
