exchange (v.) – to swap something with other people

例句：My best friend Ray exchanged home addresses with me so we could visit each other.

exchangeable		exchange rate

- exchange scholar (n.)

例句：Dr. Wesley is an exchange scholar from the United States.

- exchange rate (n.) (匯率) --the rate for the amount of money to be swapped from the currency of one country to the currency of another country, also called “rate of exchange”

例句：You may want to check the exchange rate online first before you purchase books via Amazon.com.

- exchange student (n)—a student who visits another school in another country and study there for a while

例句：I am an exchange student from Japan. I have been in Taiwan for two years.

- exchangeable (adj.)—something replaceable by something else

例句：Goods bought from the department store are exchangeable as long as they are returned in good condition.
