Nana seems a bit <u>reluctant</u> (不情願) here to <u>convey to</u> (向. . .表達) her photographer friend the personal news she carries in her heart. When she tells him the news of her mother's illness, the words seem to <u>leap abruptly from her mouth</u> (由她口中脫口而出). Cooper responds appropriately, pointing out the advantage of <u>optimism</u> (樂觀), and promising that he will pray for her. Nana speaks bravely of her <u>anxiety</u> (焦慮), and sees her mother's illness as an opportunity for her to <u>reflect on</u> (思考) her life and her family.
