1. stroll (n.): a leisurely walk

例句： Let's go for a stroll at the local night market.

To go for a stroll at the local night market is the same thing as saying, "They strolled through the local night market."

2. unique (adj.): being the only one of its kind; without an equal

例句: Every cat has a unique nose pattern.

例句: The way Jenny smiles defines her uniqueness.

例句: Every product in this store is uniquely made; there is only one made for every style.

3. necessity (n.): something that is required or indispensable.

例句: Water is a necessity for living organisms to survive.

necessary (adj.): required; indispensable

例句: Water is necessary for living organisms to survive.

To necessitate is to *make* something become necessary as a result.

例句: The conditions of house arrest necessitated John to stay at home at all times.
